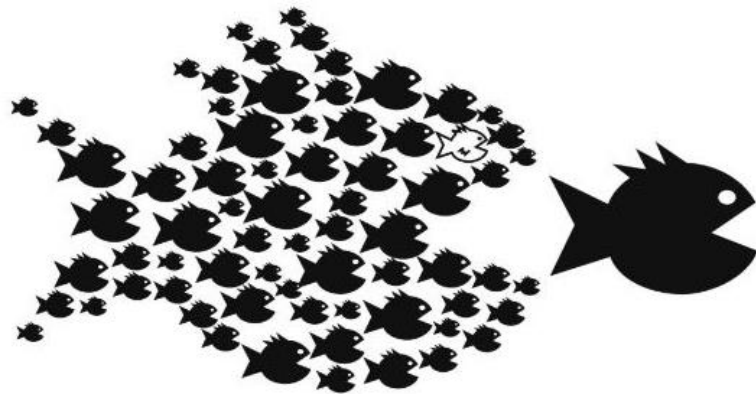

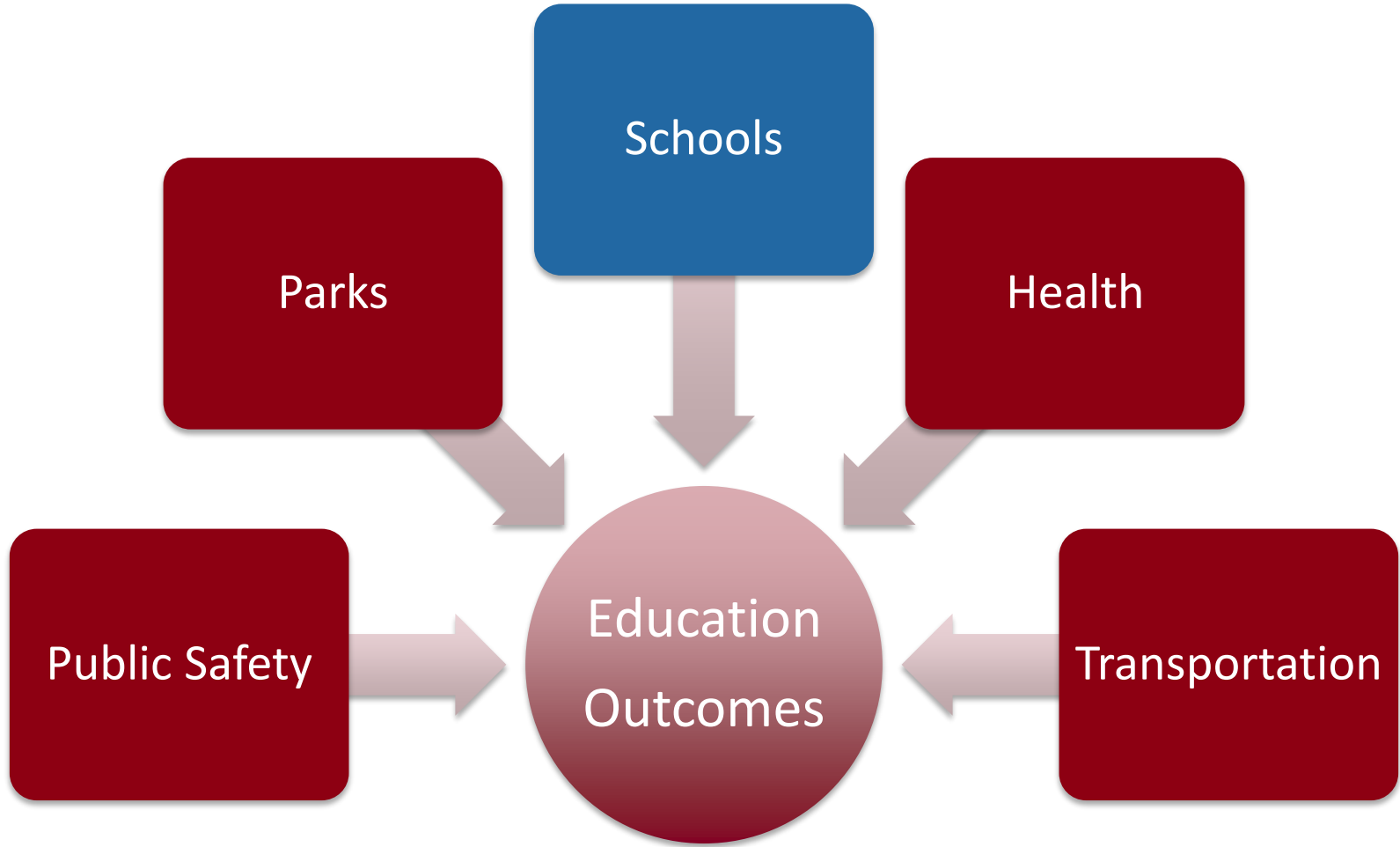


## Why Collective Impact

- Better citizen empowerment





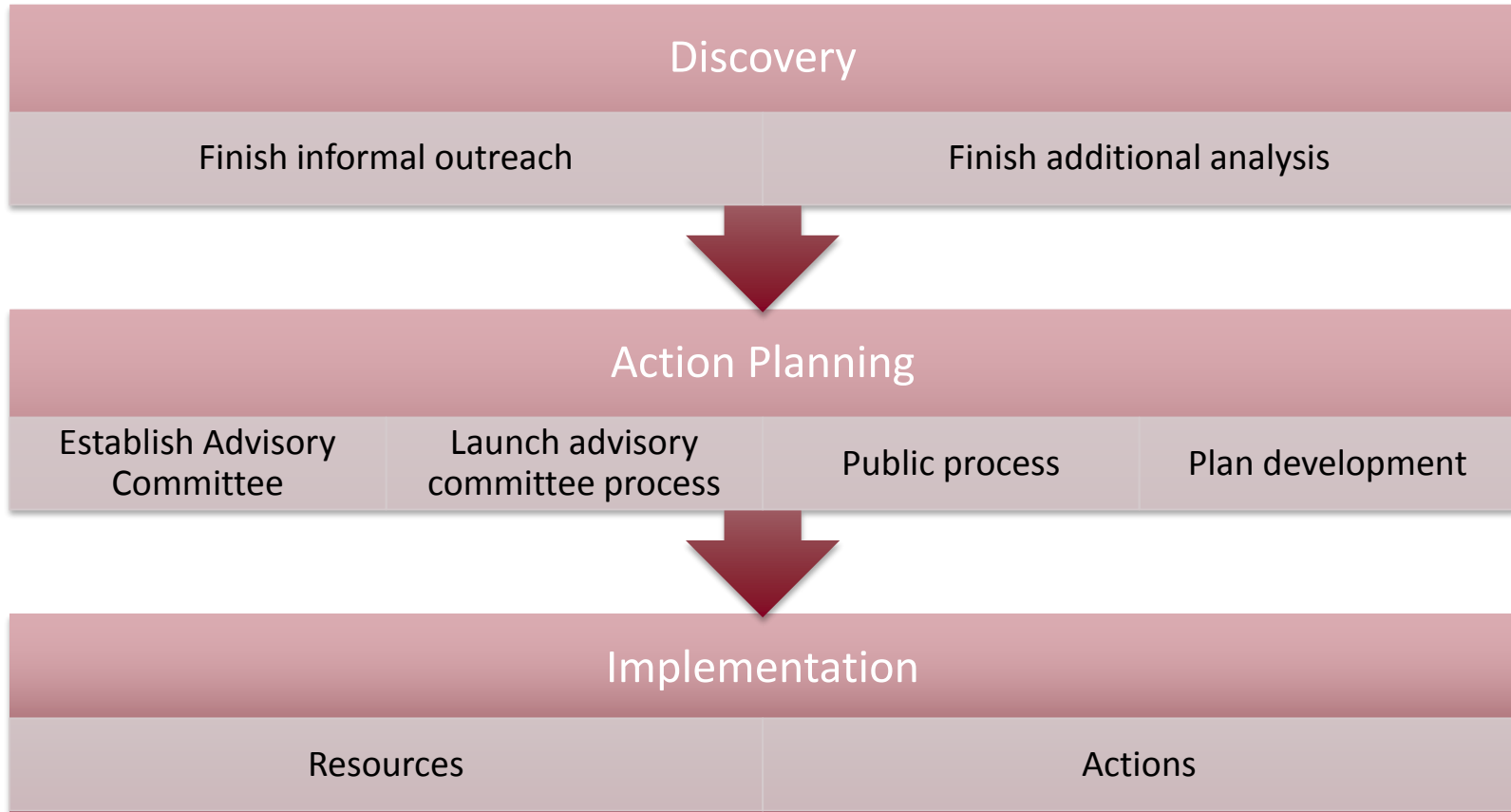


## South Wenatchee Action Plan

## Outcomes

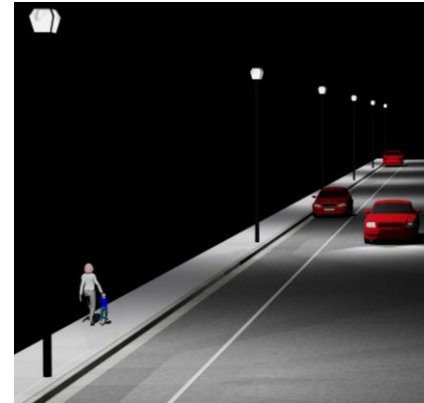
- Build relationship between community and public institutions
